Reuben Maynard is an Indigenous woodwork artist with In Place Design. Reuben loves working with epoxy resin. A mind bustling with ideas, he enjoys the grounded feeling that being an artist brings.

Jamal Akbari was born in Afghanistan and lived as a refugee in Iran before coming to Tasmania. He's been painting since he was 10, and does so when he's happy, sad, or needs to relax. His go-to themes are animals, flowers and birds.

Takira Simon Brown is a palawa artist who has been making art since she was 12. She's been a busker on the streets of nipaluna, a documentary maker and a musical stage Performer.

Josh Santopirito is a multimedia artist and graphic novelist based in nipaluna. He loves his veggie patch and his chickens and one day hopes to somehow make art about both of those things.

Jasper Kelly is a multi-disciplinary artist, working from silkscreen prints to large-scale murals that are all connected by his distinguishable characters and silly themes, often referencing Australian culture and imagery with a playful twist.


